Sniper's Hide Precision Rifle Course

The Fundamentals of Long Range Marksmanship

Course Objective: To assist the student in building a solid foundation in the Fundamentals of Marksmanship in order to assure predictable, repeatable precision and accuracy with a long-range precision rifle.

Intermediate Objectives: To introduce the student to the proper use of the equipment of long-range precision rifle and instill confidence in the student's ability to gather accurate, repeatable data to 1,000 yards and beyond.

Day One — Classroom

0900 - Welcome, Introductions and Range Safety Brief

0920 - Initial Evaluation - Live Fire Range

Live Fire - Five round group under scrutiny of Instructors.

Student receives Evaluation Sheet from each Instructor.

1000 - 1300 - Classroom Presentation, Lunch

Fundamentals of Marksmanship

Equipment and Equipment Set-up

Drop and Drift - External Ballistics

Gathering of Data - "Weaponized Math"

Wind Formulas

1300 - 1600 - Live fire Range

Scope Tracking

Scopes are removed and put through a tracking test which will reveal the true tracking of each scope. Reticles are made plum.

Scopes are re-mounted and the rifle is set up to the student.

Zeroing of Rifles and Students

Mechanical as well as physical zero is achieved, minimizing the student's influence on each shot.

Gather Data at Short Ranges

Strict adherence to fundamentals are enforced as students begin to gather data utilizing “Weaponized Math”.

1600 - Debrief of Day One

Day Two — Live Fire Range

0900 - 1200 — Gather Data at Long Range

“Weaponized Math” worksheets are utilized to ensure first-round hits at successive ranges to 1,000 yards. Students are scrutinized heavily to assure adherence to the fundamentals of marksmanship.

1200 - 1230 — Lunch

1230 - 1600 — Live Fire

Reticle Drills

Students are taught to trust the reticle and speed is introduced.

Return to Zero

Rifle / Student zeros are checked often to instill confidence.

Confirmation of Long Range Data

Students team up and re-shoot the range utilizing the skills acquired to this point.

Final Evaluation of Student - Fundamentals of Marksmanship

Instructors gauge the progress of each individual student and offer immediate feedback and correction.
