

**What's in the Range Go Bag (double check night before trip):**

	Plenty of water in bladder and/or bottles (bring a couple extra gallons and leave in car)
	Food/Snacks/Energy bars (if you're shooting hungry it can affect your accuracy)
	Ammo
	Magazines
	Magazine Holster(s)
	Suppressor with cover
	Extra batteries: AA, AAA, CR2032 (scope illum.), CR123 (weapon lights), CR2 (LRF's)
	Shooting glasses
	Hearing protection
	Shooting Gloves
	Rear Bags
	Slings
	Bipods (Atlas or Harris - one notch out for accuracy) with Talon Feet (Hawk Hill)
	LRF – Laser Range Finder w/ extra batteries
	Kestrel or similar– Wind, Density Altitude, Temperature w/ extra batteries
	Ballistic Calculator (warning: smartphones can overheat in hot sun or lose battery over a day of use)
	Chronograph w/ extra batteries
	Tripod with rifle mount (Pig Saddle or RRS VYCE) or bipod leg extensions
	Shooting Pillow
	Bag for brass collection and brass catcher (if shooting AR)
	Wrist commander with DOPE card(s)
	Data Book and/or Rite in Rain notepad with waterproof ink pen
	Seasonal gear – hat, long sleeve shirt, poncho, windbreaker, shemagh, cold weather gloves/hand warmers
	Sunscreen
	Insect Repellent
	Cheap primer (gray) spray paint for steel targets
	Shoot N C dots
	Paper Targets (if shooting paper)*
	Staple Gun with extra staples
	Masking/Painters tape
	Tools – torque wrench/bits (everything to take apart rifle or pistol) – torque everything down before trip
	Scope Tools (allen wrenches) and instructions on resetting zero, zero stop, etc.
	MPA Magazine Lip Tool (to fix bent lips when dropped)
	Case Head Separation tool (for your caliber)
	Otis Field Cleaning Kit (for your caliber(s)) with take down rod
	Lubricant (get a good sealable bottle as this stuff can leak)
	Bore Cleaning Solvent (Wipe Out Patch Out or similar - get a good sealable bottle as this stuff can leak)
	Rags (old T shirts, etc.) for cleaning up messes
	Wet wipes (always handy for cleaning stuff, hands, etc.)
	Lighter fluid (for cleaning triggers)
	Matches and Firestarter kit (you never know when these will come in handy)
	Flashlight w/ extra batteries
	Small first aid kit, ace bandage, bacitracin, band aids, ibuprofen
	Zip ties (these are handy for all kinds of stuff)
	550 Paracord (great as multipurpose rope, string, shoestring, etc.) with small carabiner(s)
	Trash bag and latex/nitrile gloves inside gallon Ziploc bag

Additional Items that don't go in the range bag:

- \* Target Stand (for paper targets) with extra target backer cardboard cutout
- Good boots for ankle and cactus protection
- Shooting Mat/Pad
