

Proper use of Rear Bag

Proper use of the rear bag is crucial to proper support of the rear of the rifle.

Insert the lower three fingers (graspers) of the non-firing hand through the strap and firmly grip the center of the bag.

The index finger and thumb make up the “pincers” and act as pincers to the “ears” of the upper rear bag, firmly holding the rear of the rifle in place during recoil and follow through.

Never compromise the rear bag’s support by allowing it to soften.

It should be straight and not angled, with the “ears” perpendicular to the line of flight. Straight and square.

Natural point of aim height should be adjusted at the bipod(!) with a firm rear bag.

Again, NEVER compromise the rear bag.

Press-Break-Freeze
