



A founding member of ELRSO and one of the founders of King of 2 Miles brings you Unholy Alliance at Black Bear Shooting Club on April 17&18. This match is designed to give new ELR shooters a good start while presenting a solid challenge to experienced shooters. Targets will be out to at least 2200 yards and we may present targets out to 3000 yards if an arrangement with neighboring land can be reached. In either case, distances and scores for heavy class will be sufficient for Ko2M qualification.

The course of fire will be sets of 2 targets with 5 shots at each in 6 minutes. There will be 3 sets on the first day and 1 set on the second day. Sight in out to 1000 yards will be available on Friday the 16th.

Shooting with a designated spotter is strongly encouraged, however shooters without a spotter may request spotting calls from match staff.

Light class will be limited to .338 caliber, 26 pounds and a .585 bolt face. Heavy class is limited to .510 caliber and 50 pounds. No steel core, armor piercing, tracer or incendiary ammo is permitted. Shooting will be prone from a bipod with no restrictions on the bipod used however spiked feet may only be used by those prepared to be mocked. Shooters with disabilities may shoot from a bench if needed however bench shot scores will not qualify for Ko2M. Guns may be supported in the rear by bags or monopods however, mechanical rear rests are not permitted. Shooting will be from peak to peak and peak to valley with a maximum decline of 14 degrees. Shooting surfaces will be level wood or pea gravel. Shooters may stack pads as needed to achieve the elevation they require however digging trenches and sandbagging are not permitted.

Fee for shooters is \$150 per class and \$250 for both classes. Lunch on Saturday will be provided and local accommodations are available for a fee on a first come first served basis. A third of match fees will be put in a pot for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place shooters of each class to split. In recognition of Earth Day (April 22) a small fraction of match fees will go towards planting tiny little trees which we will blow up in your honor.
