

Situational Ethics Question

This is a situational ethics question. The scenario below is one which could possibly happen. You will be presented with the information then asked to choose a course of action.

There are no right or wrong answers but be prepared to justify your answer.

Here is the scenario:

You live in an upscale neighborhood in suburbia. The neighbors are an eclectic group with a great deal of diversity and education levels. The house that you live in is at the end of a cul-de-sac. One of your more colorful neighbors lives near the entrance of the cul-de-sac about two houses from your home.

This neighbor's yard is festooned with Biden-Harris, BLM, ANTIFA, anti-gun and COVID vaccination signs. She's very outspoken on her beliefs that all guns should be banned. Anything that she disagrees with is considered hate speech. She believes that anyone criticizing the CDC or Dr. Fauci should be put on a terrorist watch list. If she had her way, they would all be in "re-education centers" with their children placed in approved foster homes.

She's garnered lots of media attention with her gun buy-back programs and petitions to the city to ban gun stores and anyone with FFLs from inside the city limits. She has even petitioned the state legislature to release the names and address of everyone that has CCW permits.

Your neighbor exhibits a particular disdain for homeschoolers and calls them Neanderthals. She's an atheist with the "coexist" bumper sticker on her car.
